Term 5 Growth and Change

What can you do at home to help your child?

Read and share story books

Point out numbers to your child when you are out together and counting aloud together.

Encourage independent skills, e.g. getting dressed and good hygiene care such as hand washing

Communication and Language

Listening to stories and recalling the main features.

Recalling past events in our lives using the correct past tense.

FS1 (Nursery):

FS2 (Reception)
