**Maths** Number and place value: reading, writing and ordering numbers up to and across 100. Addition and Subtraction: using pictorial representations such as a numberline to support calculation. Multiplication and Division: sorting objects and numbers into equal groups and arrays. Measurement: continue to explore length, height, weight, volume; Chronological Time. Geometry: position and direction.

**Literacy** Exploring a variety of texts to develop reading and writing skills such as vocabulary, character descriptions and retelling of stories and traditional tales, poetry and rhyme. Lists, labels and instructions. Reading regularly in class and at home. Grammar: developing sentences, remembering to use capital letters and full stops, applying suffixes and prefixes to extend words.

**Science** Exploring our five senses to enhance our wellbeing and discover the world around us - everyday materials, classifying animals including humans, the changing seasons, healthy eating.

**PSHE** Emotions - exploring how we can understand others feelings.

**Computing** learning to use technology safely and respectfully, create and debug simple programmes.

**Music** Musical Minis - exploring pulse and rhythm through songs and music games with un-tuned percussion instruments. Experimenting with, creating and combining sounds using the interrelated dimensions of music. Wellbeing through music.
